Chincoteague/Wallops Island,

“Developing, Testing, and Sustaining Phased Array Systems in the 21st Century”

The American Society of Naval Engineers (ASNE) Wallops Island Chapter of the Tidewater Section, in conjunction with the Surface Combat Systems Center (SCSC) Wallops Island VA, will host a one and one-half day ASNE Combat Systems Mini-Symposium at the Chincoteague Center in Chincoteague, VA on 7-8 October 2004. The symposium will be held the Thursday and Friday prior to the famous “Chincoteague Island Oyster Festival”. Theme. “Developing, Testing, and Sustaining Phased Array Systems in the 21st Century”. SCSC currently supports several phased array systems including the three AEGIS SPY-1 radars, the SPS-48E, the SPQ-9B, and development efforts for the SPY-3 Multi-Function Radar (MFR). In addition, plans are in progress to construct a DD (X) facility on Wallops Island. This facility will house several phased array systems including the Volume Search Radar (VSR) and the MFR.
